

2026 PIT Quick Guidance

Point-in-Time Count

PIT for Clarity HMIS projects:

- 1) UNL-CCFL will pull PIT data for projects participating in the Clarity HMIS. Only clients who are literally homeless according to HUD's definition will be pulled into the PIT report.
- 2) We need your support to make sure that your project has the most current information on the Client Profile tab and Client Enrollment screen.
- 3) To pulled as enrolled all housing projects must make sure clients have an entry into your housing projects on or before January 27th, 2026, and that they are still active on this date.

We will pull PIT data for HMIS on Friday, February 13th, 2026.

All NON-Clarity HMIS Agencies that supply housing for the homeless, including Churches and DV providers:

- 1) If your agency utilizes a comparable database (ex: Osnimum, Vela, DVIMS etc.) you will use your system to pull a Point-in-Time report or CAPER report.
- 2) On the morning of January 27th, 2026, you will receive the 2026 Sheltered PIT Submission Template for your organization. *This template will be in an excel format.*
- 3) You will return the Point-in-Time or CAPER report, alongside the 2026 Sheltered PIT Submission Template to Ciara Orr corr14@nebraska.edu.

Submissions are due by Friday, February 13th, 2026.

All Street Outreach coming into contact with individuals living in a place not meant for habitation on the night of January 27th, 2026 during the dusk to dawn hours must collect: Clarity ID (if available), Full name (first and last), DOB, Sex, and Race and Ethnicity. Street Outreach staff will collect the required information on the 2026 Street Outreach PIT Unsheltered Form provided. Only collected on individuals and their household members with a primary night-time residence that is a public or private place not designed for or ordinarily used as regular sleeping accommodation for human beings, such as a car, park and abandoned building.
